



Collegial Critique Peer Support Teams.

Roles and Responsibilities

It is beneficial for the group member tasks to be distributed for fair share work among the members of the team. They may rotate in each session. Teams advance their cohesion by assessing role performance monthly.

Coach: Makes and guides agenda, keeps group on task, assures fair share contributions, guides assessment at end of the session.

Encourager: Guides encouragement for fair share, active engagement and team support of individual work, coaches positive remarks and atmosphere.

Recorder: Records group tasks on newsprint for all to see. Keeps record of roles and schedule.

Reporter: Leads preparation of presentations; mc's presentation so that all members do fair share. Assists recorder and makes placement of items in team blog.

Clock watcher: Keeps time so that sessions start and end as scheduled and maintain agreed upon pace

Materials Manager: Brings/arranges for equipment needed for session and other materials including easel, newsprint, markers and tape. Stores material for following meetings. Individuals bring own laptops, cords, surge protectors, etc.

Other roles as determined by team.
